A Pacific Northwest U.S. native circa 1837, the *Indian Hyacinth* is best grown in moist, fertile soil in full sun to partial sunlight. Commercially grown in the Netherlands for decades, unlike most bulbs, it prefers soil that has a bit more moisture. Deer- and rodent-resistant, C. quamash forms ever substantive clusters of linear strappy foliage around upright racemes studded with dozens of six-petaled, 2", star-shaped lavender-blue flowers with yellow anthers and whisper-green centers. The flowers open sequentially from the bottom to the top. Bulb size: 6 cm/up. Full to partial sunlight. Bloom time in horticultural zone 5: May/June. HZ: 4-8. Height: 15".







Ornithogalum Balansae

Circa 1884, this miniature heirloom yields slender stems adorned with up to five star-shaped white flowers with faint green stripes, tiny glowing green centers and yellow anthers, and somewhat sparse linear foliage. As it matures over time, when it's extremely happy where it's planted, it can naturalize by both bulb offsets (called bulbils: baby bulbs on the sides of the mother bulb you've planted) and, occasionally, selfsowing seed. Since it's not tremendously hardy, you may want to apply no more than a 2" layer of mulch after the surface of the ground freezes to protect it from winter temperature spiking in the event of inconsistent snow coverage. You'll need about nine bulbs per square foot. (Square footage is determined multiplying the planting site's length times its width.) Bulb size: 5 cm/up. Full to partial sunlight. Bloom time in horticultural zone 5: March/April. Plant 4" to 6" deep and 4" to 6" apart. HZ: 5-8. Height: 5".

Scilla bifolia rosea

Also known as Scilla bifolia carnea or the Alpine Squill, this lightly scented 17th century naturalizer has trusses of starshaped light pink florets and strappy foliage. It's a lovely addition to rock gardens, woodlands and garden borders. Generally referred to as Wood Squill, deer- and rodentresistant Scilla naturalize readily in areas of light shade or dappled sunlight. When it's really happy where planted, it can naturalize by both bulb offsets (baby bulbs on the sides of the mother bulb you've planted) and self-sowing seed. You'll need about nine bulbs per square foot. (Square footage is determined multiplying the planting site's length times its width.) In woodland settings, you can also scatter-plant the bulbs for a more natural look. Bulb size: 5 cm/up. Full to partial sunlight. Bloom time in horticultural zone 5: early spring. Plant 5" deep and 4" to 6" apart. HZ: 4-8. Height: 4" to 5". (Scilla are also good for forcing indoors over the winter. Pot them up in mid-October and precool them at a consistent, dark 38° to 45°F for six to eight weeks with moderate watering. Bring them into the house~they will bloom about two to four weeks later.)






